Education At our Monthly Meetings, a featured speaker covers a specific woodworking discipline each month. Members are encouraged to bring in samples of their work, a new tool, jig or fixture to share with the group. **Skill Development Classes** are available. The club also has an extensive **Book & Video Library** available to members.

Community Service Past projects include decorating a tree for the Festival of Trees and Lights, Toys for Kids, building and distributing toys to local hospitals and homeless shelters, building a pergola for Amanda the Panda Family Grief Center, and building 2,000 catapults for the Boy Scouts.

Networking with other members can help you find answers on woodworking technique, how to use and buy tools, and where to buy supplies. Many members have started their workshops with tools purchased from other members.

Dues are \$30 for new members for your first year. Renewal is \$25 per year if paid before membership expires.
